The Youth Director at St. George Cathedral is a ministry staff position responsible for all parish programs directed toward children, teens, and young adults. The Youth Director exercises his or her ministry under the supervision of the Dean and Assistant Pastor of the Cathedral. The right person for this position is a deeply committed Orthodox Christian and a highly motivated self-starter dedicated to building up young people in Christ. The applicant understands contemporary youth culture and serves as a good role model of Christian character for youth.

Specific Responsibilities

- Oversee & develop the current youth ministry programs of the parish
 - Church School (Pre-kindergarten through 12th grade)
 - Vacation Bible School Program (Pre-kindergarten through 5th grade)
 - Direct Teen SOYO (7th – 12th grades) & supervise teen activities
 - Develop/lead "Family Night" programs for children as well as Teen SOYO Bible studies
 - Coordinate YABOY Ministry (4th, 5th & 6th grades)
 - Oversee Altar server program together with lay volunteer leader

- Coordinate Creative Festival participation
 - Work with Bible Bowl teams

 - Manage the Youth Ministry budget
 - Coordinate camping program
 - Coordinate Camp St Raphael Summer and Winter Camp arrangements & scholarship program
 - Serve in Camp St Raphael staff position as needed
